

Curriculum Area: Social - Emotional Recommended for: 2 years plus Learning Activity: Pretend Play

Big Idea:

Dramatic Play

What to do:

Make use of household items to create opprotunities for pretend play.

Some ideas include:

-Old mobile phones (or blocks) to encourgae conversation. -Creating a picinic scenario by offering bowls, cups, plates etc.

-Proving patty pans, large mixing bowl and spoon to create a cooking scenario.

Benefits:

In these moments, children are able to gain a deeper sense of identity and express their imagination. Valuable opportunities arise for children to practice turn taking, listening the to and fro of conversations.
