

Curriculum Area: Visual Art and STEM Recommended for: 2 years plus Learning Activity: Going on a leaf hunt

Big Idea:

We can go on adventures just like in the story!

What to do:

Encourage your child to pick leaves and place them in a basket. As well, to look at the trees and the differences in the leaves.

At home, discuss your child's leaf findings and suggest creating a collage. You will need glue and paper. During the collage, you can talk about the characteristic of the leaves such as colour, size, type and names to stimulate your child's language.

Before you visit the outdoors, you can watch the video of the story book "We're going on a Leaf Hunt", by Steve Metzger. Have fun!
